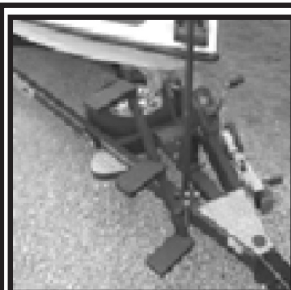

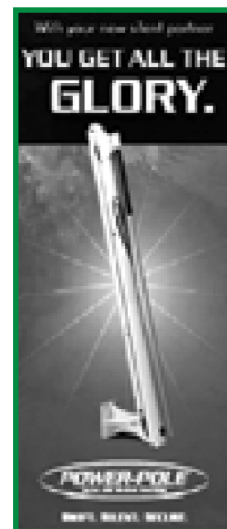
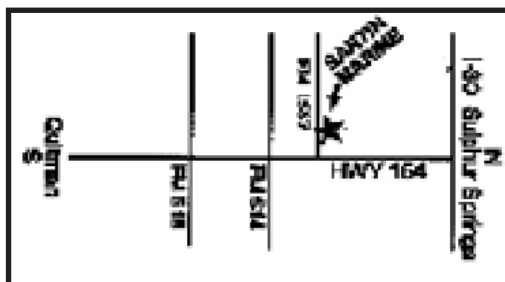

Strollin' With Stroman

The dog days of summer are upon us with one hundred degree days and seventy to eighty degree nights. When the wind is bellowing, the day time fishing can be downright miserable. The best big bass fishing is at night and good night trips start with adequate preparation. There are several don'ts you need to be aware of if you are planning a night time trip. Always make sure you are familiar with the area you are going to fish. Don't make a night trip to unfamiliar water and don't wear white clothing after dark. Green, gray or blue are preferable. White clothes will attract every

bug from miles away.

Take plenty of bug spray. Even though most bugs will not bite, the repellent will help keep them from crawling on you all night. Make sure your batteries are fully charged. You will be using more battery power because your lights will be on all night. Don't turn off your running lights. It is the law. Running lights must be on after dark. If you don't keep them on, you will meet one of our game wardens. They don't accept any excuses for safety violations. Keep them on.

Get to your fishing area before dark and familiarize yourself with the surrounding area. Make sure you have a good, well-charged portable (See Strollin'....

light for knot tying and fish landing. Night fishing can be very rewarding. Being prepared can make a big difference.

Bass are active at night during late spring and summer months. Telemetry studies have shown largemouth bass concentrate as much as ninety percent of their activity during the night hours when water temperature is above seventy-six degrees. Water oxygen content will affect bass activity at night. During the day plants con-

vert carbon dioxide to oxygen. After dark the water around aquatic plants such as hydrilla have some of the highest concentrations of oxygen of the twenty-four hour period. However, during night time hours, plants start using oxygen in the water and the levels will drop as darkness proceeds. During this period from dark until dawn most feeding bass will move to the outside edges to feed.

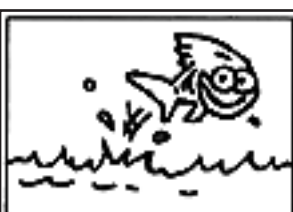

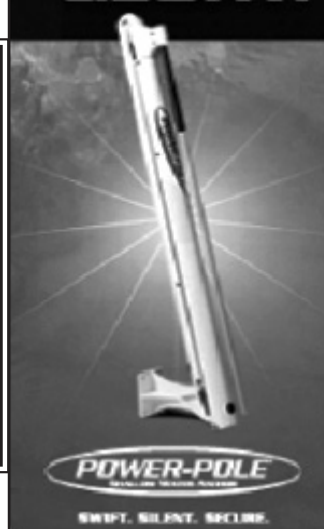

SeaPak Island Quesadillas With Lime Sour Cream

1 package (12 oz) SeaPak Shrimp Scampi-Butter and Garlic, frozen
4 pineapple rounds (fresh or canned in juice), about 1" thick

8 (fajita-size) flour tortillas, regular or whole wheat

2 cups Monterey Jack cheese or Mexican cheese blend, shredded

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup roasted red peppers, chopped

$\frac{1}{4}$ cup scallions, chopped

Cooking spray

$\frac{1}{2}$ cup sour cream

2 Tbsp. chopped fresh cilantro

1 tsp. lime zest, finely grated

$\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. garlic powder

PREHEAT oven to 400 degrees. Coat a large baking sheet with cooking spray.

COAT a large skillet with cooking spray and set over medium-high heat to pre-heat. Place pineapple rounds on hot pan

and cook 2 minutes per side, until golden brown. Remove from pan and set aside. Add shrimp to hot pan and cook according to package directions. Lift shrimp from butter sauce (discard butter sauce if desired) and cut shrimp and pineapple into $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces.

ARRANGE four tortillas on prepared baking sheet. Top tortillas with cheese ($\frac{1}{2}$ cup each), shrimp, pineapple, roasted red peppers and scallions. Place second tortilla on top and spray the surface with cooking spray. Cover quesadillas with foil and bake 5 minutes. Uncover and back 5 to 7 more minutes, un-

til cheese melts and tortillas are golden brown. Meanwhile, in a small bowl, combine sour cream, cilantro, lime zest and garlic. Mix well.

SLICE quesadillas into wedges and serve with lime sour cream on the side.

Texas Game Wardens Enhance BWI Enforcement Efforts

Law enforcement officers across the U.S. were geared up for Operation Dry Water - the nation's boating while intoxicated (BWI) awareness and enforcement campaign. The nationwide event took place June 27-29.

Alcohol use is the leading known contributing factor in recreational boater deaths in the United States. "Texas Game Wardens as well as their law enforcement partners were on heightened alert for those violating boating under the influence laws," said Cody Jones, TPWD Law Enforcement Assistant Commander for Marine Enforcement and Texas State Boating Law Administrator.

In 2013, officers from across the country contacted 144,044 recreational boaters and made 290 BWI arrests during the three-day weekend. Thousands of law enforcement officers, along with their boating safety partners, were on the water during Operation Dry Water educating boaters about the dangers of boating under the influence of drugs and alcohol as well as removing from the water those who choose to boat impaired.

"Game Wardens will continue to remind Texans through education and enforcement to always have a designated driver while boating on our lakes and rivers," said LTC Danny Shaw, TPWD Law Enforcement Deputy Director. "Our purpose

is to provide everyone an opportunity to safely enjoy themselves on the water and return home at the end of the day. We will have enhanced Game Warden patrols through the remainder of the summer and our officers will be on high alert for those who choose to place themselves and others in danger by drinking and operating vessels on our public waters."

"The mission of Operation Dry Water and the law enforcement officers who participate is to reduce the number of alcohol- and drug-related deaths on the water," says John Fetterman, National Association of State Boating Law Administrators (NASBLA) Deputy Executive Director. "Boating should be a fun and enjoyable time spent with friends and family; we are asking that boaters make sure their voyage remains enjoy-

able by boating sober. Too many accidents and deaths are caused by those who choose to boat under the influence."

In addition to having a designated driver, TPWD stresses the following four key points to decrease boating and water related accidents, injuries, and deaths.

1. Wear a life jacket. 70 percent of persons who died in a boating accident would be alive today, if they had worn a life jacket.
2. Use the ignition safety switch, commonly called a "kill switch" to stop the engine if you fall overboard. Don't be stranded, or run over by your boat.
3. Learn how to swim.
4. Take a Boater Education course from Texas Parks and Wildlife: It could save your life.
